4. I can identify symbols from the Baptismal liturgy that express this belief.

5. I have a greater understanding of the titles given to Jesus in the stories studied in this unit.
6. I can provide examples of how Christ is like a light for his followers today.
7. I can ask questions about the meaning and purpose of Baptism.

Lent: Living as Followers of Jesus Today

8. I know some reasons associated with the Church's practice of prayer, fasting and almsgiving during the season of Lent.
9. I know some of Jesus' teaching about forgiveness and will understand that this is a gift God freely gives.
10. I know that the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a celebration of this gift.
11. I know that Christians are called to follow Christ by the way they live their lives.
12. I understand that the Beatitudes of Jesus provide a guide for this.

15. I understand some reasons why Christians seek the forgiveness of God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.


